INTRODUCTION

The disciples were caught in a storm on the Sea of Galilee and they were terrified. Jesus walks on water in the midst of the storm and tells the disciples "Be encouraged, It's me, don't be afraid." This story is about something that happened on the Sea of Galilee a long time ago, but it's recorded in the Gospel because it's something that happens in our lives all the time if we just realize it. What can we learn about Jesus and what it means to be a disciple from this passage?

Monday: Matthew 8:14-17

Too often, Christians either focus their ministry to God's world exclusively on preaching eternal salvation through Jesus, or else exclusively on making the conditions of life in this broken world better. Jesus clearly did both. What did Peter (and what do you, as one who follows Jesus the way Peter did) learn from observing Jesus' pattern of ministry?

Tuesday: Mark 1:32-39

Peter seemed content then to see Jesus' popularity spreading through Capernaum (some students estimate the town's population at about 1500). Jesus already had a broader focus— "he traveled throughout Galilee." He ultimately commissioned Peter and all his followers to "go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). How far do your hopes and visions for God's Kingdom extend? In what ways can you play your part in making that vision a reality?

Wednesday: Matthew 15:10-16

Jesus often introduced teaching with phrases like "Listen and understand" he used in this reading. What people, publications or practices have helped you most in gaining greater understanding of Jesus' teaching and how to apply it in your faith life? In what ways would you like to increase your understanding?

Thursday: Psalm 107:23-31, Mark 4:35-41

Only God, the Hebrews believed, could restrain the sea's stormy chaos (cf. Jeremiah 5:22). Our world still faces many "storms." Have you seen God in any way bring peace during such storms and their aftermath? If so, list ways you've seen or still see God at work for good in these tragic situations.

Friday: Matthew 14:21-26

"On a popular level, many Gentiles and probably a number of Jews believed in ghosts, although such a belief technically contradicted mainstream Jewish views of the afterlife (heaven or hell and future resurrection)." * What fears, if any, do you deal with based on popular culture, even though they may not fit into your more careful understanding of Jesus' teachings?

MOVING FORWARD

Three things we learn from our story of Jesus and Peter on the Sea of Galilee. 1) When we look at Jesus we see God. 2) The Christian faith calls us to step outside of our boats (comfort zone). 3) In the midst of the storm Christ walks with you. This week, reflect on which one of these lessons you need to focus on. Then take that next step that Jesus has called you to take.

Answers to the sermon notes: IA) disciple, B) yes, C) storm. IIA) afraid, B) Peter, C) worshiped. IIIA) faith, B) boat, C) hand.
