

ASBURY DAILY STUDY GUIDE *April 18-22, 2022*

Monday: I Corinthians 15:3-20

Paul was absolutely confident in Christ's resurrection. He saw it as a physical fact, but also as a reality that shaped his own life, inevitable death and ultimate resurrection as well. Would Christianity mean anything without Christ's death and resurrection? How would your life be different if there was no resurrection?

Tuesday: Luke 24:1-12

What was Jesus' closest followers' initial response to the empty tomb? Do you identify with the disciples' doubts about the resurrection? How does their subsequent belief affect the credibility of their testimonies?

Wednesday: Acts 4:8-13

The reason we know anything about Jesus, the reason we even know he ever lived, is because of the witnesses who poured into the streets of Jerusalem and said "we've seen him alive after the crucifixion." Do you agree with the idea that the foundation of Christians' faith is the event of the resurrection? Why or why not?

Thursday: Luke 24:44-48

What are your favorite memories of Easter as a child? What meaning was attached to Jesus' death for you then?

Friday: John 20:1-10

Mary Magdalene believed Jesus was a great teacher, she believed he was from God, she believed that he was a miracle worker, she believed he was an extraordinary communicator, she believed he was like no other person that she had ever met. She also believed he was dead and would stay dead after the crucifixion. Why do you think people pay attention to Jesus' teachings even if they don't believe in his resurrection?
