INTRODUCTION

Is there more than one way to get to heaven? If we say "Jesus is the only way," isn't it going to sound very narrow minded, snobbish and exclusive. In a world filled with contradicting ideas, there can only be one truth. What's the difference between Jesus being the "best" way, and him being the only way?

When we believe that Jesus is the only way to heaven, we are simply believing what Jesus himself said. That is not being narrow minded, we are rationally responding to the evidence presented. If there was another way to save us from sin, Jesus would not have come to earth. Our response is to place our faith in Christ, tell others about Jesus, remember what he has done and celebrate.

- 4) Do you think it's important to introduce people to Jesus that don't know the Gospel message?
- 5) Is taking communion, important to you spiritually? Why or why not?
