INTRODUCTION

Income inequality is the uneven distribution of income among individuals, groups, or populations. It's a major factor in social stratification and social class. In the United States, the income gap between the rich and everyone else has been growing markedly, by every major statistical measure, for more than 30 years. So what does Scripture say about this issue?

Solutions to income inequality vary and they are frequently debated. Although there are no simple solutions, scripture is clear that income inequality is exacerbated by what Jesus refers to as the deceitfulness of riches. And scripture is also clear that those with excess resources need to share with the poor. And as the richest nation on earth, the United States needs to be a light to the world with this problem.
