SMALL GROUP STUDY GUIDE

Week 3 May 18, 2025 "Dr. Chris Hena"

INTRODUCTION

As the "Voices" series came to a close, Dr. Chris Hena, a medical missionary in Liberia and long-time Asbury Mission partner, shared her experience with us. This week, our questions aim to spark discussion through various thoughts on serving others, one of the core actions of a follower of Jesus.

As followers of Jesus, we have a story to share; and words are only complimentary to telling it. We seek to serve the world with God's love through word and deed, striving to follow the mission Christ set out for us: to make disciples of all nations.

QUESTIONS

- 1. Read 1 John 3:18 (on page 1). When has an action communicated to you in a way that words couldn't? How do you seek to use your actions to show love and compassion to others?
- 2. When have you made a bold step for Jesus? What were the challenges and rewards of taking that step? When have you been given an opportunity to make a bold step but didn't take it? Do you have regrets from not taking it?
- 3. Proverbs 11:25 says we can be "refreshed [by] refresh[ing] others." How have you seen this in your life?
- 4. Read Matthew's account of Jesus calling the disciples (Matthew 4:18-22, on page 1). A teacher asking a student to follow means that the teacher sees potential in the student and has confidence that student can be taught. When has someone taken a chance on you and left an indelible mark on your life? How has it impacted the way you strive to care for and influence others?
- 5. What are small actions that you can take to care for others on a daily basis? How do you use your gifts, time, and talents to show God's love, even (maybe especially) without words?

FINAL APPLICATION

Pray together the following prayer, asking for Jesus' help in showing his love to others through the way you live:

"Lord, let my actions speak Your truth, Your will, and Your way. Amen."
